With a flexible approach to working which will be discussed at interview, you will be involved in a range of areas, including administration as well as providing analytical, modelling and data processing support.

You will respond to information requests to provide data, run reports and develop dashboards through the application of analytical and data handling skills. You will also have the opportunity to work with our data warehousing and acquisition team, who pull health data from across NHS Wales.

To support your work with this team, you will also undertake a part time higher degree apprenticeship in Data Science at University of Wales Trinity Saint David commencing in September 2021.

INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY TEAM (3 APPRENTICESHIP POSTS)

Based in our Cardiff office, you will gain experience in a number of areas within our ICT Directorate which is responsible for a multitude of digital services across NHS Wales including: Cyber Security, Cloud services, Networking, Monitoring, Server & SAN storage, Telephony, Video Conferencing, DNS, Redhat Linux, SQL, Authentication, Office 365 plus a range of other core infrastructure services.

The work area includes providing an accurate and efficient administrative service and will support the management of the national data centres and cloud environments which host the centrally provided NHS Wales clinical and critical systems.
