Norway's Data Protection Authority plans to fine the dating app 100m Norwegian Crowns (£8.5m), or around 10% of Grindr's estimated global revenue for illegally selling user data to advertisers.

ICO News: Fines totalling £480,000 issued to companies making nuisance calls

The Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) has issued fines totalling £480,000 to four separate companies for making unlawful calls to numbers registered with the Telephone Preference Service.
