[First Tier Tribunal \(Information Rights\): Joseph Baldwin v The Information Commissioner \[EA/2018/0023\]](#)

The First Tier Tribunal (Information Rights) has found that the Information Commissioner was incorrect in finding that the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) should have applied the section 40(5)(b)(i) FOIA exemption (exemption from the obligation to confirm or deny) in response to a request for information relating to a complaint about named nurses. The Tribunal upheld the decision of the NMC that the section 40(2) FOIA exemption (third party personal information) applied.

The UK Government has passed a draft Statutory Instrument to amend the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2003 (PECR), the UK version of the GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018 to insert appropriate references to ensure the legislation works in UK domestic law post-Brexit. The functions currently carried out by the European Commission in the GDPR will be transferred to the Secretary of State or the Information Commissioner.
