News Article: NHS trust fined for 56 Dean Street HIV status leak An NHS trust has been fined £180,000 after a sexual health centre leaked the details of almost 800 patients who had attended HIV clinics.

<u>News Article: Gender identity clinic leaks patient email addresses</u> A London gender identity clinic has mistakenly exposed details of close to 2,000 people on its email list.

<u>ICO News: SMOs must "prepare for all scenarios" to maintain data flows when UK leaves the EU</u> The Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) has urged businesses to "prepare for all scenarios" as it publishes dedicated guidance to help small and medium sized organisations prepare for the possibility that the UK leaves the European Union with no deal.

<u>News Article: ICO to probe government over Gov.uk data collection plan</u> The ICO is to look into the government's leaked data collection plans over fears they may breach data protection legislation.

<u>News Article: Data bosses 'currently considering' if some private parking fines break GDPR laws</u> The ICO is currently considering if the way some parking fines are handed out is not compliant with data protection legislation.
