News Article: Facebook faces investigation over data breach

The Irish Data Protection Commission is to launch an investigation into a data leak in which the details of hundreds of millions of Facebook users were published online. It had previously been looking into claims from Facebook that the data was old, from a previously reported leak in 2019. But it now says that there could have been a breach of data laws.

News Article: Estate agent's hi-tech house tour exposes personal data

An estate agent has apologised after a 3D tour of a house for sale in Devon was published with a substantial amount of personal information visible.

Financial paperwork in the study could be read by zooming in on the image. It included a shares dividend cheque, an insurance policy document and an invoice for a stairlift. Some family photos had also been left unblurred. Fowlers estate agent said the private data in the virtual tour had "slipped past" its staff and the home owner.

News Article: Google 'partially' misled consumers over collecting location data, Australian court finds
Google has been found to have "partially" misled Australian consumers about collecting their location data, according to a federal court ruling handed down on Friday.

The court found that Google continued to collect "Location History" on some Android and Pixel phones, even for customers who ticked "No" or "Do not collect" on their settings. [Relates to Australia]
