## News Article: Spanish Data Protection Agency Issues Highest Ever Fine

Vodafone Spain has been hit with the highest ever fine to be issued by the Spanish Data Protection Agency. The telecommunications company was financially penalised in four separate fines totalling \$9.72m over its use of aggressive telemarketing tactics and its failure to protect data. [Relates to Spain]
