Since rolling out in May 2018, there have been 340 GDPR fines issued by European data protection authorities. Every one of the 28 EU nations, plus the United Kingdom, has issued at least one GDPR fine, according to a new report.

30% of employees are handling more data and that more than a third (37%) anticipated an increase in both the number and value of data breach fines by 2025 according to a new survey.
