## WISB COMMENTS:

- Members were informed that the data for the numerator and denominator was provided by the Welsh Ambulance Trust. In this way it was similar to other aggregate counts where the detail of assigning activity to defined categories was undertaken by the service provider and only the counts were provided centrally.
- Members noted that they were unfamiliar with the processes by which these times were measured.
- 3. Members queried how the allocation of calls to either Category A or C was determined following the withdrawal of Category B. Such detail would be included in any submissions relating to the underlying data collection.
- 4. Members asked for detail on the reporting currency to be included in the publication.
