Type of Change: Revision of NHS data standard

Reason for change: Inadequate description of a national code.

Background: This DSCN specifies a change to the description of a national code

within the attribute ATTENDED OR DID NOT ATTEND. "Appointment cancelled by the patient" is not suitable for the

situation where a patient's appointment is cancelled as a result of the

patient being deceased. This DSCN rectifies the inadequate

description.

CHANGES

Change Type: Change data item description

ATTENDED OR DID NOT ATTEND

(OP MDS)

This indicates whether a person or patient attended for an appointment. If the patient did not attend, it also indicates whether or not advanced warning was given.

Format: 1 digit numeric

Meaning
Patient arrived on time or, if late, before the
relevant health care professional was ready to see
them
Patient arrived late, after the relevant health care
professional was first ready to see them, but was
seen
Patient arrived late and could not be seen
Appointment cancelled by, or on behalf of, the
patient
Did not attend - no advanced warning given
Appointment cancelled or postponed by the
health care provider

The classification has been listed in logical sequence rather then in numeric order.
