DATA SET CHANGE NOTICE

A Data Set Change Notice (DSCN) is an information mandate for a new or revised information standard.

This DSCN was approved by the Welsh Information Governance and Standards Board (WIGSB) at its meeting on the 20th May 2010

DATA SET CHANGE NOTICE

Outpatient Activity Minimum Data Set (OP MDS) Data Validity Standards

Introduction

A range of data validity standards have been developed for the Outpatient Minimum Data Set (OP MDS). These were mandated via Ministerial Letter (ML/EH/001/010) effective from 1st April 2010. During the development of the standards and the associated monitoring mechanisms required to support them, it became apparent that the NHS Wales Data Dictionary needed to be updated as historical code changes were not reflected in the Dictionary. This addition will ensure that the Dictionary comprehensively outlines all the code values and their valid to/from dates. This will assist LHBs and Trusts in their provision of valid OP activity data.

Many OP MDS data items are also constituents of the Admitted Patient Care (APC) data set. These were updated as part of the work associated with the implementation of the APC Data Validity Standards. This DSCN covers all changes to the remaining data items exclusive to the OP MDS.

The historic codes for all data items used within the OP MDS have been checked back to Version 1.1 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary, with all codes valid before this version being highlighted as pre 28th December 1995.

Description of Change

To update the NHS Wales Data Dictionary to ensure that any historical code changes for all data items within the OP MDS are reflected.

Data Dictionary Version

This DSCN will be reflected in version 3.1 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

Actions Required

Local Health Boards and Trusts are asked to:

- Ensure that the data items they submit within the OP MDS hold valid values in relation to the attendance date that applies to each OP record.

Health Solutions Wales (HSW) is required to:

- Ensure all tools associated with the monitoring and reporting of OP activity data validity (e.g. Validation at Source, OP Data Validity Performance Monitoring Report) fully reflect all the historical code changes outlined within this DSCN.

The first attendance is the start of the Outpatient episode and is the first attendance in a series with the same Consultant or Independent Nurse following a referral.
