DATA SET CHANGE NOTICE

Introduction

The 1983 Mental Health Act covers the compulsory admission and detention in hospital of mentally disordered persons; it provides the legal framework for their care and treatment, and includes matters relating to care outside of hospital settings. The 1983 Act was amended by the Mental Health Act 2007. These changes to the 1983 Act took place in 2007 and 2008 and at that time brought about the need to amend and add data to existing collection tools of the Welsh Assembly Government.

Annual information in relation to the 1983 Act is required to be collected centrally in order to monitor the number and type of detentions, as well as identify variations in detention rates across reporting periods and within different areas in Wales. Such information is used for trend analysis as well as informing funding arrangements.

Description of Change

To change the reporting requirements of the KP90 Annual Return as a result of updates to the Mental Health Act 1983 and to introduce the data collection tool to the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.
