DATA SET CHANGE NOTICE

Introduction

Healthcare Resource Groups (HRGs) were introduced to NHS Wales in April 2000. HRG version 3.5 has been in use since October 2003 in NHS Trusts, Powys Local Health Board and Health Solutions Wales (HSW). In England, HRG version 4 was introduced for Reference Costs from April 2006 and for National Tariff from April 2009.

In April 2009, WIGSB approved the use of HRG version 4 by HSW for the purpose of grouping Admitted Patient Care (APC) data. At that time Local Health Boards (LHBs) and Velindre NHS Trust were required to continue to submit HRG version 3.5 codes in the APC data set. There was, and still is, no mandate or capacity to include HRG 4 codes in the submitted APC data set.

England no longer supports the development of HRG 3.5. As a result there have not been any enhancements to the HRG 3.5 grouper for the last two years. Furthermore, although OPCS 4.5 and 4.6 have been developed to support greater granularity of HRG codes, this benefit is lost if classification codes are mapped back to OPCS 4.2 in order to be grouped to HRG 3.5.

HRG 3.5 is no longer required for financial costing purposes. A small consultation exercise has shown that no other national stakeholders require its use to be continued. As a consequence of this, there is no longer a requirement to submit HRG 3.5 codes in the APC data set.

Description of Change

The withdrawal of the requirement to submit HRG v3.5 groups in the APC data set.

Data Dictionary Version

This DSCN will be reflected in version 3.3 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.



Actions Required

Actions for the NHS Wales Informatics Service (NWIS):

- 1. For APC activity with an episode end date before 1st April 2011:
 - Continue to check the validity of submitted HRG v3.5 codes via the Validation at Source Service (VASS)¹.
 - Continue to populate ePEDW² and any other affected national reports with valid HRG 3.5 codes.
- 2. For APC activity with an episode end date after 1st April 2011:
 - Decommission the data validity check and associated data validity performance indicator for HRG v3.5 codes in VASS and the monthly APC Data Validity Performance Monitoring Report.
 - Discontinue the reporting of HRG 3.5 data validity performance in the monthly Clinical Coding Data Quality Report³ for financial year 2011/12 activity onwards.

Actions for LHBs / Trusts:

- 1. For APC activity with an episode end date before 1st April 2011:
 - LHBs / Trusts should ensure a valid HRG version 3.5 code is submitted within the APC episode in the APC data set.
- 2. For APC activity with an episode end date on or after 1st April 2011:
 - LHBs / Trusts are no longer required to submit a valid HRG version 3.5 code. However, the submission of a valid code is permissible until further notice.
 - If the LHB / Trust does not wish to submit a valid HRG version 3.5 code, the field should be populated with zeros ('000') or padded with spaces. No data quality monitoring will be undertaken on this field for activity on or after 1st April 2011.
