DATA SET CHANGE NOTICE

Introduction

In England DSCN 20/2004 – GMS Contract Patient Registrations – introduced the new arrangements for patients being registered with GP Practices rather than with individual GPs. Further DSCNs, DSCN 03/2008 and DSCN 13/2008 provided clarification on the content and format of the information that would be expected to be submitted centrally by English Primary Care Trusts.

In Wales, WHC (2004) 008 – New GMS Project Implementation – detailed the implementation of the GMS Contract across NHS Wales. Further guidance was provided within WHC (2005) 044 – New GMS Contract: Extended IM&T Guidance.

DSCN (2007)11(W) renamed the data item 'Code of GP Practice (Registered GMP)' to 'GP Practice Code' and where applicable removed GP Code from the following data sets: Outpatient Data Set Critical Care Data Set EAL Data Set

Subsequently developed national data sets such as Outpatient Referrals have only included GP Practice Code.

In the case of the Admitted Patient Care (APC) Data Set, since 2007 GP Practice Code has been derived by the NHS Wales Informatics Service for national reporting using the submitted GP Code.

This DSCN introduces GP Practice Code into the Admitted Patient Care Data Set.

Description of Change

To introduce 'GP Practice Code' into the APC data set, effective from 1st September 2012.

Data Dictionary Version

Where applicable, this DSCN reflects changes introduced by DSCN and/or DDCN since the release of version 4.0 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

The changes introduced by such DSCNs will be published in version 4.1 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.



Actions Required

Actions for Local Health Boards / Trusts: -

• From 1st September ensure 'GP Practice Code' is submitted in the APC data set in accordance with the instructions set out in this DSCN. This relates to September data submitted in October.

Actions for the NHS Wales Informatics Service (NWIS): -

- From 1st September 2012, ensure that the NHS Wales Data Switching Service (NWDSS) is updated to allow 'GP Practice Code' to be submitted.
- Switch of the derivation of GP Practice Code and populate the field with submitted GP Practice Code.
- From 1st September 2012, introduce a new data validity check within the Validation at Source Service (VASS) for 'GP Practice Code'.
- From 1st September 2012, decommission the VASS check for <u>'General Medical</u> <u>Practitioner (Registered) (50144)</u>.

The use of default codes

V81999 – should only be used where it is not possible to determine a patients registered practice code, for instance the patient cannot communicate and is unidentifiable.



Where a 5 character code is used, it should be left justified and padded with a space.

Dental Practice Code

The code described by the Organisation Data Service (ODS) as a Dental Practice Code identifies an individual dental practice location. This code should be used as the 'Referring Organisation Code' for referrals made to the Trust.

Format: 6 character alpha-numeric

The first character is set as a V

Characters 2 to 6 are the last 5 digits of the Location ID taken from a Provider Dentist Contract number

Structure

Each GP code begins with the letter G.

The 2nd to 7th characters are the DH Index Number. Index Numbers and addresses are issued quarterly by the Prescription Pricing Authority (PPA). The eighth character is a check digit calculated thus:

first numeric character

- + 3 x second character
- + 7 x third character
- + 1 x fourth character
- + 3 x fifth character
- + 7 x sixth character

The check digit is then the unit digit (last digit) of the result of this calculation.

e.g. PPA code 334512. Check digit is computed by:

 $3 + (3 \times 3) + (7 \times 4) + 5 + (3 \times 1) + (7 \times 2) = 62$

The check digit is 2 and the full code G3345122.
