#### **DATA STANDARDS CHANGE NOTICE**

#### Introduction

The existing <u>National Data Set for Sexual Health Services in Wales</u> was introduced in December 2018. The aim of the data set was to collect information that would better reflect the services offered by integrated clinics, which includes contraception and other sexual health activity.

There is now a requirement to update the Standard to reflect additional local codes created to support clinical need (since approved for national use) and any other changes deemed necessary to make the information collection current.

# **Description of Change**

To amend the existing National Data Set for Sexual Health Services in Wales as described in the Information Specification below.

Sexual health services are defined as those provided within NHS Wales; however, it is envisaged that this Standard could be applied to Third Sector Providers in the future.

# **Data Dictionary Version**

Where applicable, this DSCN reflects changes introduced by DSCN and/or DDCN since the release of version 4.17 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

The changes introduced by such DSCNs will be published in version 4.18 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

### **Actions Required**

NHS Wales Sexual Health Services:

- Work with Public Health Wales to:
  - Adopt the information requirements as described in this DSCN, and to adopt the national activity codes.
  - o Follow a structured mechanism so that all coding changes are reviewed and approved for national use, ensuring that reporting is standardised and accurately interpreted to reflect the situation in Wales, e.g., see *Activity Code*.

#### Public Health Wales:

- Draft and provide NHS Wales Sexual Health Services with additional clinical guidance for use in conjunction with this Standard.
- Work with software solution providers and project colleagues to ensure adoption of the Standard in any future software development or procurement for the collection and transfer of such information.

#### Digital Health and Care Wales:

 Create a reference set for Activity Code and a process for Public Health Wales to request new codes as proposed by NHS Wales Sexual Health Services.

### Information Requirements from 1st January 2019 1st June 2023 Onwards

**Note:** The purpose of mandating the dataset is not to direct sexual history taking but to record activity in the clinic. Sexual history taking is down to the discretion of the clinician in line with existing clinical practice guidance

The Reference IDs in the previous table below have been removed as these were not used as part of the Standard or implementation is provided for navigation within this document only; it is not a code within the data

The code *UNK – Unknown* is the least detailed of all the 'null' values and simply means that the information is not known or wasn't recorded. The reason a piece of information is not recorded, or provided, is beneficial to understanding information collection, consequently it is important to select one of the more detailed 'null' values where possible e.g. *ASKX – Asked but declined* should be used where the patient was asked for the information but declined to answer, *ASKU – Asked but unknown* should be used where the patient was asked for the information but was unsure how to respond or didn't know, *NASK - Not Asked* should be used where the patient was not asked for the information.

If it is the case that the Core Reference Data Standards changes do not get approved, this would result in those specific codes in the National Data Set for Sexual Health Services in Wales to be mapped to achieve future interoperability.

Not assessed indicates that the Data Item has not been collected. This would be at the discretion of the clinician in line with existing clinical practice quidance.

Unknown indicates that the clinician has attempted to collect the information from the patient but was unable to record a response (this could be for a variety of reasons e.g., patient was asked but declined to provide a response.)

The only exceptions to the above are:

GP Practice Code where Unknown is as the definition in the NHS Wales Data Dictionary i.e., where it is not possible to determine a patients registered practice code, for instance the patient cannot communicate and is unidentifiable.

HIV Status where Unknown reflects patients who do not have HIV codes that indicate they are positive (HIV care, HIV positive, HIV diagnosis codes), and do not have any HIV testing codes.

Gender of Patient, Gender Identity Same at Birth, and Ethnicity, which comply with NHS Digital Standards and use the term Not Stated to denote that patient was asked but declined to provide a response.
