DATA STANDARDS CHANGE NOTICE

<u>Introduction</u>

The primary purpose of the Admitted Patient Care (APC) data set is to provide activity figures for admitted care. However, this data set is also used to calculate waiting times for admitted care.

The maternity tail data items were identified for retirement from the APC data set when the Maternity Indicators data set was implemented in 2016, however, the changes were not progressed. Analysis on usage of the data items showed that, only 2 health boards currently provide data, and so it was progressed via the IQI working group review process.

During the consultation in the IQI working group, it was agreed unanimously by all Health Boards for the maternity tail data items to be retired.

It has been confirmed that these fields are not currently used for any national and local reporting.

Description of Change

This DSCN officially retires the 22 maternity tail data items from the Admitted Patient Care data set.

Data Dictionary Version

Where applicable, this DSCN reflects changes introduced by DSCN and/or DDCN since the release of version 4.16 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

The changes introduced by such DSCNs will be published in version 4.17 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.
