DATA STANDARDS CHANGE NOTICE

A Data Standards Change Notice (DSCN) is an information mandate for a new or revised information standard.

This DSCN was approved by the Welsh Information Standards Board (WISB) at its meeting on Thursday 16th November 2023.

DATA STANDARDS CHANGE NOTICE

Introduction

Following the inclusion of Nurse Activity in the Outpatient Data Set (OP Ds) and Outpatient Referral Data Set (OPR Ds), discussions have been taking place within IQI (Information Quality Improvement Group) to look at the way in which Nurse Activity is currently being conducted and captured in the Admitted Patient Care Data Set (APC Ds).

The change was introduced in the OP Ds and OPR Ds to update the Data Item Consultant Code, to support the national submission of the Registration Number for any nurse (including midwives) meeting the definition of Clinic Appointment (Non Consultant/Nurse Led). Where the Registration Number for the nurse or midwife is not registered with the Welsh Reference Data Service (WRDS), that the following codes should be used:

- o M9999998 Midwife
- o N9999998 Nurse

Currently in the APC Ds, Midwife Led Code Unknown (M9999998) is a valid value. However, Nurse/Midwife Pins and Nurse Led Code Unknown (N9999998) are not valid values. Meaning any use of Nurse Pins is flagged as invalid activity.

It has been established that as a result reporting inconsistencies exist across Wales, due to Nurse activity that is occurring in all health boards, but is recorded in a variety of ways in the APC submission. E.g. submitted as done but as a result failing checks, or Nurse activity assigned under consultants in the data submissions in order to pass checks. Therefore, it has been agreed by Welsh Government to align the APC scope with the OPR/OPA Data sets to include Nurse Led activity.

Description of Change

To increase the scope of the Admitted Patient Care data set (APC ds) to include nurse led activity, specifically to:

- Update the definition scope of the APC Ds to encompass activity as outlined in Appendix B.
- Update the Data Item Consultant Code to support the national submission of the Registration Number for any nurse (including midwives) meeting the definition of Clinic Appointment (Non Consultant/Nurse Led). Where the Registration Number for the nurse or midwife is not registered with the Welsh Reference Data Service (WRDS), that the following codes should be used:
 - o M9999998 Midwife
 - N9999998 Nurse

Data Dictionary Version

Where applicable, this DSCN reflects changes introduced by DSCN and/or DDCN since the release of version 4.19 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

The changes introduced by such DSCNs will be published in version 4.20 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

Actions Required

Actions for Local Health Boards / Trusts:

- Apply the additional clarity provided by the scope definitions for the APC Ds
- Implement the revised scope and work to add nurse and midwife registration numbers to the Welsh Reference Data Service (WRDS) and incorporate these identifiers into APC Ds records from 1st April 2024

Actions for Digital Health and Care Wales:

• Update Validity VASS check 50115 to include Nursing Pins

Admitted Patient Care Data Set (APC Ds)

Scope

The Admitted Patient Care (APC) data set captures data for all consultant-led or non-consultant/nurse led (including Midwives) admitted patient activity, regardless of the patient's area of residence.

Once admitted a patient may have several episodes within a hospital spell. All episodes, including unfinished episodes should be captured within the APC data set. Any activity which is not undertaken by a consultant or non-consultant/nurse led (or a member of their firm) should be excluded.

All NHS activity regardless of the care provider is included. Private patients seen at an NHS organisation are also included.

From April 2009 assessment unit activity has been required to be reported in the APC data set.

NHS Digital provide data on Welsh resident or registered patients treated in English NHS organisations.
